# READINGS FOR 27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading:

The prophet Habakkuk (600 BC), surrounded in his time by a people of violence, strife and greed, poses an age old question: how can God tolerate radical and extensive evil in his creation? In those days the Israelites did not enjoy our consolation of life after death. Nonetheless the prophet challenges his countrymen and us to trust that Yahweh will fulfil his covenant of ultimate care for us all. This trust has always sustained the upright.

### **Second Reading**

Timothy was one of the Church's first bishops and Paul counsels him "to fan into a flame the gift (faith) that God (had given him)". With the help of the Holy Spirit Timothy must stand for Christ and guard 'the sound teaching' he had received.

# Gospel

Jesus' teaching had doubtless been a steep and challenging climb for the Apostles. They may have felt that their faith needed strengthening. Jesus' answer is that faith is the greatest force in the world. What looks impossible becomes possible with faith. The last four verses of today's reading teach that we can never put God in our debt. A faithful servant is not be proud for doing his duty. "It may be possible to satisfy the claims of law; but lovers knows that nothing exhausts the claims of love." (William Barclay).
