**SAINT BRIGID** Tuesday, 1 February 2021, is the Feast of Saint Brigid, Abbess and Secondary Patron of Ireland. Saint Brigid is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. Saint Brigid was born in 454 and she went on to found a double monastery in Kildare with the assistance of Bishop Conleth. The Saint Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection. **A Blessing of the Crosses will take place during 10am Mass on Tuesday, 1st February in St Aengus' Church Burt** 

**THE PRESENTATION OF OUR LORD (CANDLEMAS DAY)** on Wednesday February 2nd the Church commerates the occasion when the Virgin Mary, in obedience to Jewish law, went to the Temple in Jerusalem both to be purified 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and to present him to God as her firstborn (Luke 2:22–38). The festival was formerly known in the Roman Catholic Church as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is now known as the Presentation of the Lord.

A blessing of the Candles will take place during 10am Mass on Wednesday, 2nd February in St Aengus' Church Burt and Candles will also be blessed in the St Mura's Church Fahan during 10am Mass on Friday, 4th February.

**ST BLAISE** The Feast of St Blaise is in on Thursday February 3. Not much is known about St Blaise except that he is the patron saint of sore throats and wild animals. More is known about devotion to him rather than his life itself. On his feast day, the anointing of the sick takes place. Traditionally two candles are blessed, crossed over and pressed against either side of one's throat as a blessing is said. St Blaise was a physician who eventually was ordained a bishop in the 4th Century and he worked hard to encourage the spiritual and physical health of his followers. His protection of those with throat ailments comes from a story of a woman whose son had a fish bone lodged in his throat. The woman brought her son to St Blaise who instantly healed him just as the boy was on the point of death. A general blessing of throats will take place during 10am Mass on Thursday, 3rd February in St Aengus' Church Burt. Please take your own candles for the blessing.

### **Readings for Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**First Reading**: Jeremiah was sent by God in 626 BC to warn against decadence and alliances with pagan nations. But his passionate warnings were rejected and he lived through the burning of the Temple and two separate deportations of the Jews to Babylon. In today's Gospel Jesus too refuses 'to dance to his listeners' tune'. He is violently rejected by his townspeople, with whom he had grown up.

**Second Reading** The love Paul describes here is the love Jesus spoke of when he summarised the 10 Commandments into two, love of God and love of neighbour, opposite sides of the one coin. Jesus in himself completes the Blessed Trinity's millennia –long self-revelation of themselves as essentially self-sacrificing love. This is the theme tune of Christ's Kingdom and the core undertaking to which our Baptism commits us.

**Gospel** The Nazarenes had entertained a cosy expectation that Jesus would perform even greater miracles for his own neighbours than he had done in Capernaum. But Jesus knew what was in their hearts and how far those hearts were from his Kingdom. How little the reading from Isaiah that had just been read meant to them is shown in the rage that attended upon his refusal to perform for them. The event foreshadows Good Friday.
